#### **Travel Directions**

##### **Airport-to-Hotel Directions (and back):**

The hotel is about ten miles west of Logan airport.

The best option financially is to take public transportation, aka “the T”. Start at the Logan Airport Terminal. Take Massport Subway Shuttle (33) towards the Loop (2 stops). Get off at the Airport Subway Station; walk to station (~ 4 minutes). At Airport Station, take the Blue Line subway towards Bowdoin (4 stops). Get off at Government Center Station. Take Green Line trolley (C) - towards Cleveland Circle outbound (11 stops). Get off at the Coolidge Corner T-stop (in Brookline).

The T-stop at Coolidge Corner is a short walk (~ 4 minutes) to the hotel. Head west on Beacon Street past Harvard Street towards Webster. Take a left on Webster Street and the Hotel will be directly on the right. The route can be taken directly back to the airport from the hotel. Estimate about one hour for the trip in either direction.

If you prefer, you can take a taxi which may run \$46-\$50 each way depending on traffic etc. (This includes tolls etc.) The taxi ride could be 30-60 minutes depending on traffic.

##### **Hotel-to-Campus Directions (and back):**

The hotel is about 2.5 miles from Boston College's campus.

Go to the Coolidge Corner T-stop (on Beacon Street, near the hotel) and take the “Cleveland Circle” outbound trolley line about seven stops (headed west) to its terminus at Cleveland Circle. Get off there and walk north on Chestnut Hill Ave about two blocks to get to the "Boston College" outbound trolley line that runs along Commonwealth Avenue. Take that trolley outbound (headed west) about two stops to its terminus (“Boston College” T-stop) at Lake Street. Upon exiting at the Boston College T-Stop turn left and walk to the corner making a right on to FR. Herlihy Drive. Proceed down the short block to Campanella Way. Turn right on Campanella Way and Vanderslice Hall will be directly on the left.

To return to the hotel or airport from campus simply reverse each of the routes.
